





Success criteria for Cornwall pilot



A pilot that is replicable, scalable, sustainable and has communities at its heart

- Accessible model for community energy groups
- Makes use of local electricity generation
- Benefits for local residents
- Accommodates technology and market changes
- Retains value
- Has potential to overcome any regulatory or commercial barriers
- Is financially viable and sustainable

- Complex Site/Energy Local Club
- Cornwall time of use tariff
- Automated demand-generation matching
- Aggregator ESCO
- Trading platform
- Licence exempt private network
- Network leasing or buy-out
- Mass microgen rollout
