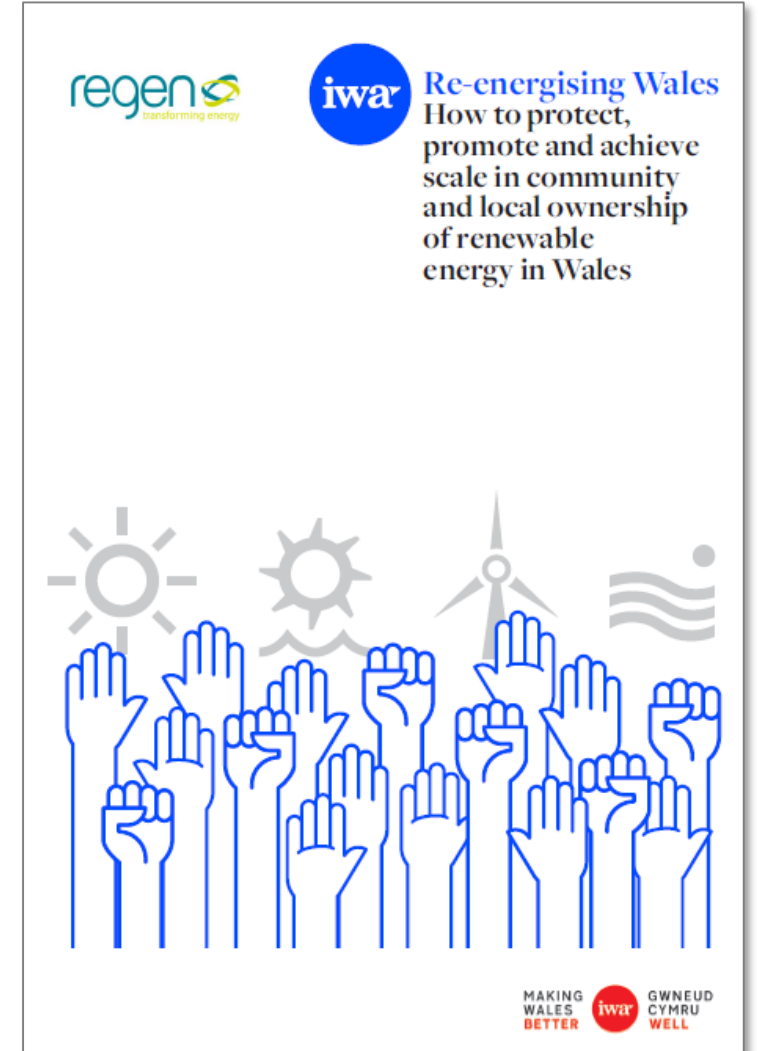


Re-energising Wales
