- Communication pathways (inc DG Owner Operator portal)






### National Grid Electricity Distribution Outages 2023


### **South West**

Seabank / Sandford 132kV Reconfiguration;

- Started in 2017. Completion due for 2024.
- Included new Sandford 400/132kV GSP.

Included redirection of two 132kV OH lines which would have required significant curtailment of three connected 33kV DG sites.

Outages studied by our Primary Network Design department which resulted in a elimination / reduction in curtailment due to other generators not yet connected to the network.




### **South Wales**

Upper Boat GSP Rebuild.

Included replacement of existing 33kV switchboard and all associated interplant cables.

Installed telecontrollable 33kV switch on our network to eliminate extensive curtailment of a 33kV connected solar park.



### **East Midlands**


Staythorpe - Cotham Grange - Grantham North

Upcoming planned 132kV OH line refurbishment.

Project requires full outage of a 132kV connected solar park (site is connected in the 'dead zone' so no other options).

Projects Engineer in discussions with customer to look at ways to reduce impact of outage;


- Working evenings / weekends to reduce outage length.
- Breaking jumpers (if possible depending on network design).



### **West Midlands**

### Meaford 33kV Substation

New GT & extension of 33kV busbars to facilitate connection of new DG site.
 Proposed to install several spare 33kV breakers to allow for future connections / network reinforcement.



## Once project is confirmed, outages will be submitted by Local Area teams.

Outage planner will determine if any DG site curtailment / outages are required.

If outages are for significant length of time, our DSO team can undertaken bespoke outage specific studies to see if curtailment levels can be improved / lifted.




### **NGED DG Portal**


