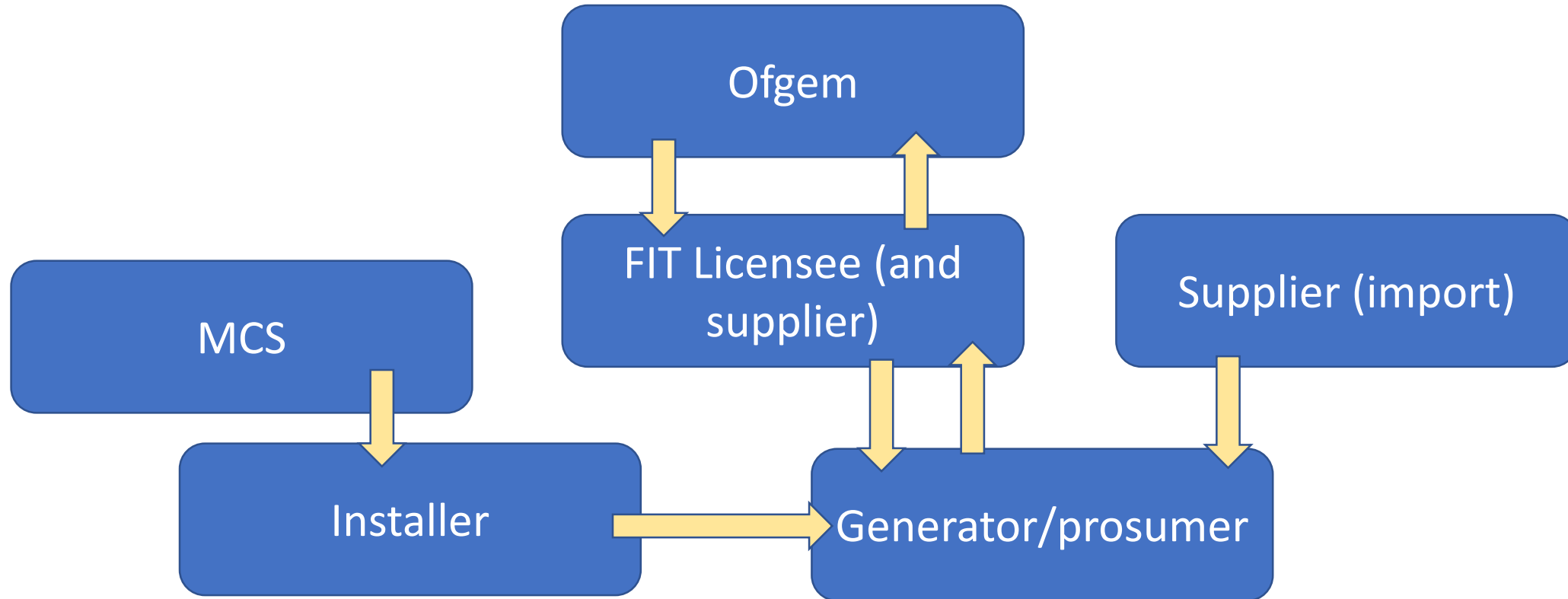

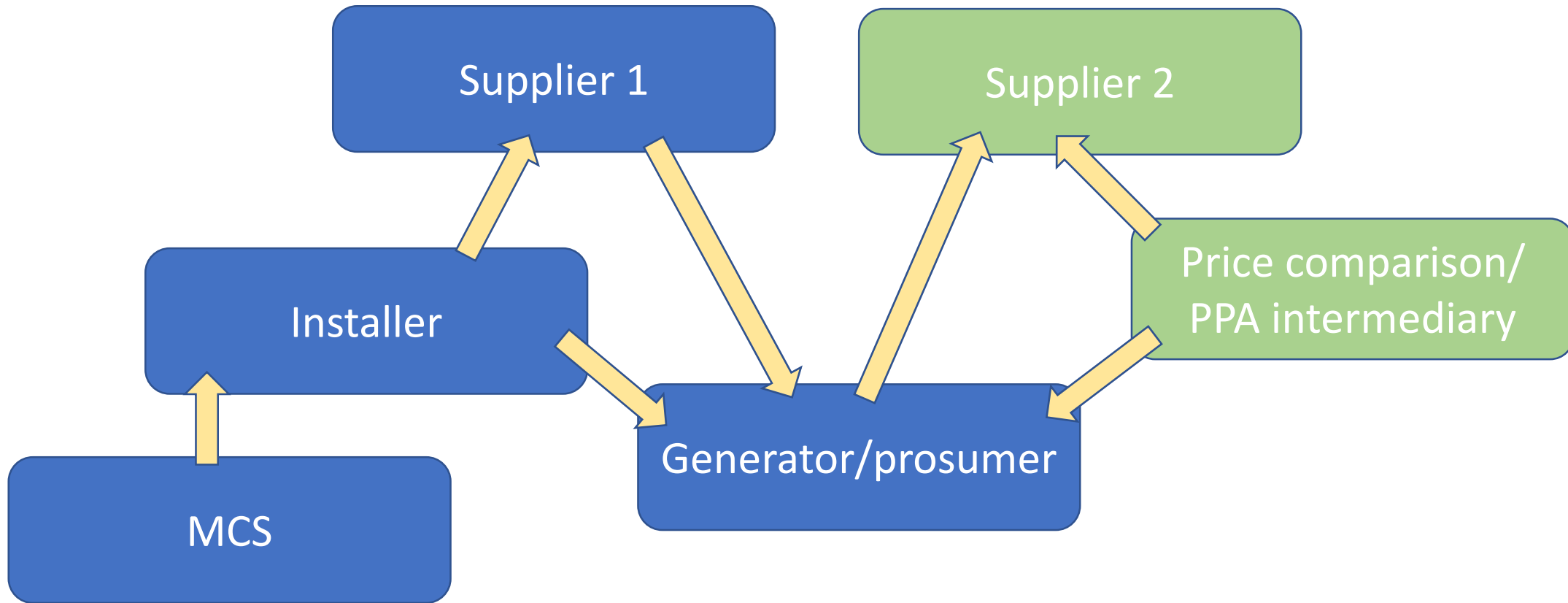

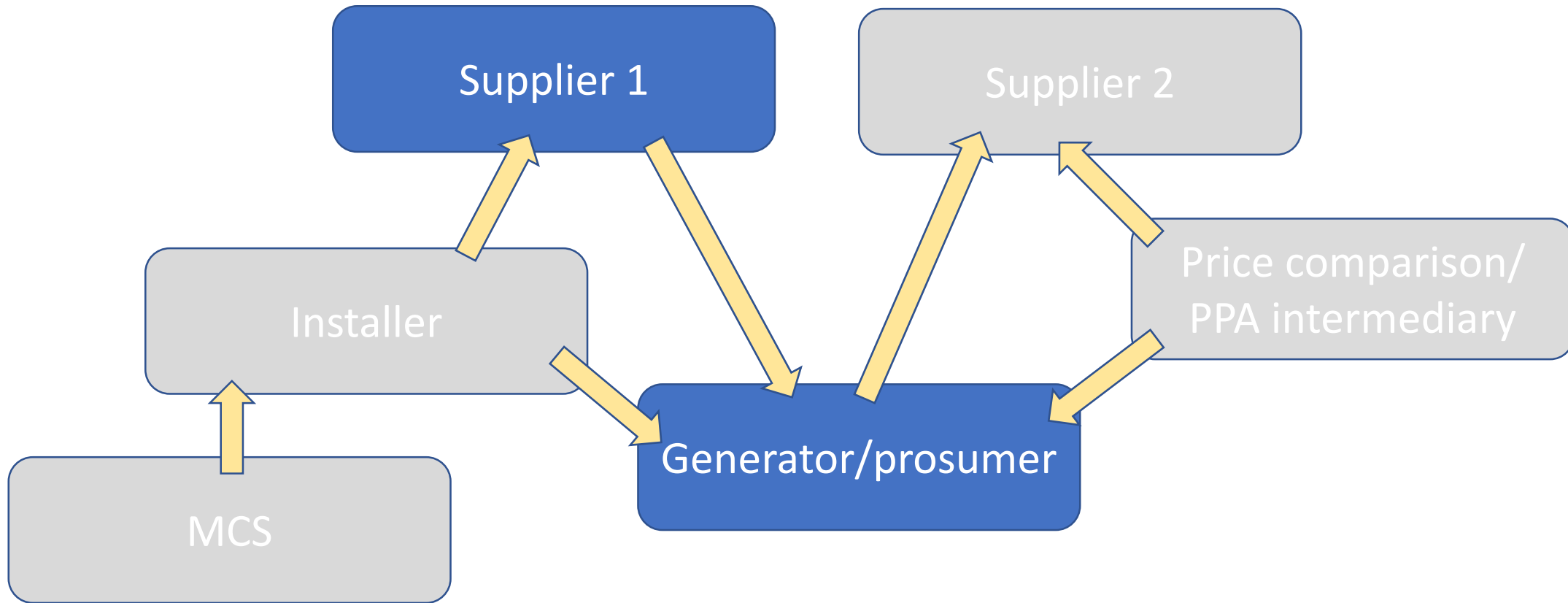
The existing relationships surrounding the Feed-in Tariff are well-established



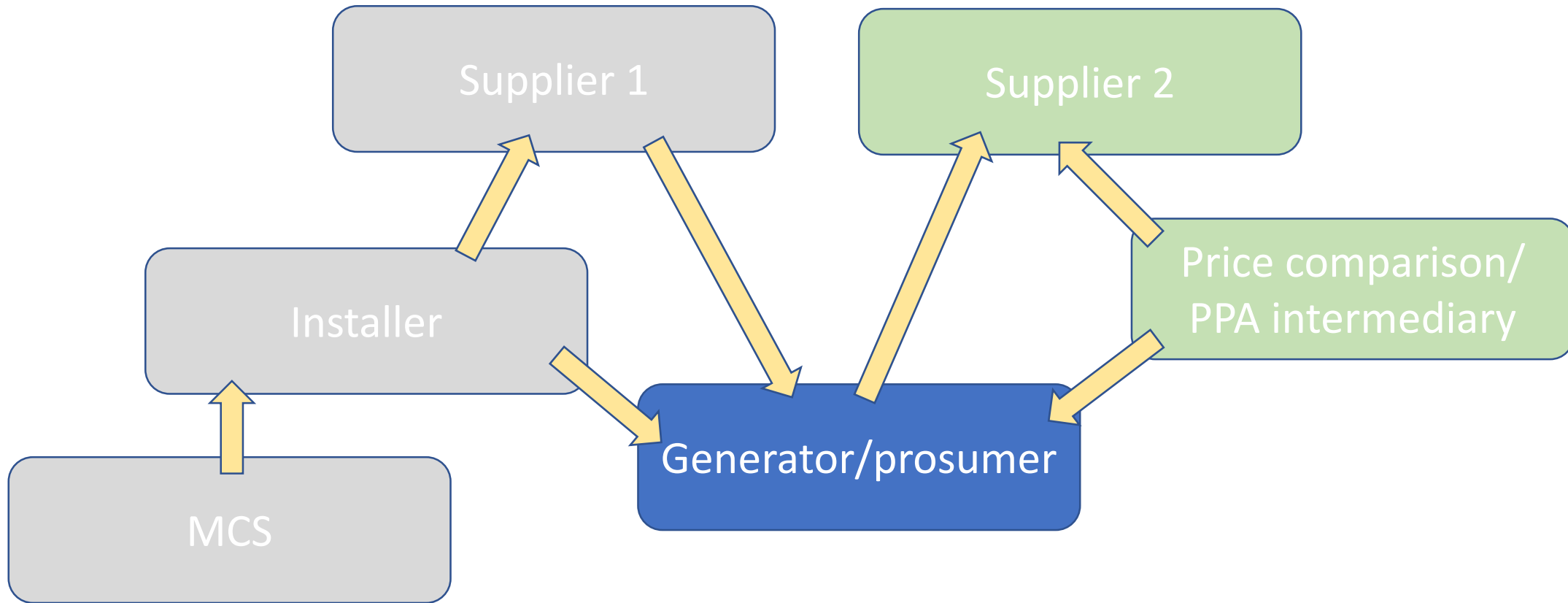
The Smart Export Guarantee could change the existing relationships between stakeholders



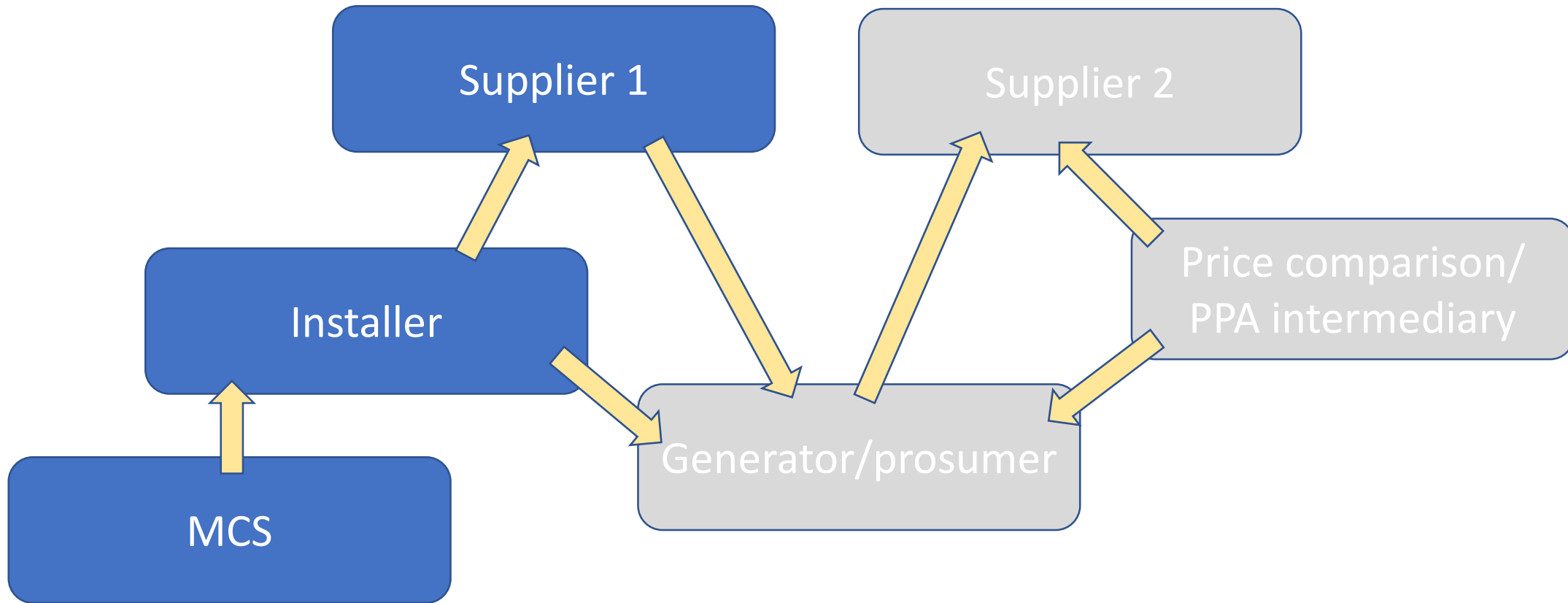
The fundamental change is the supplier and generator/prosumer relationship

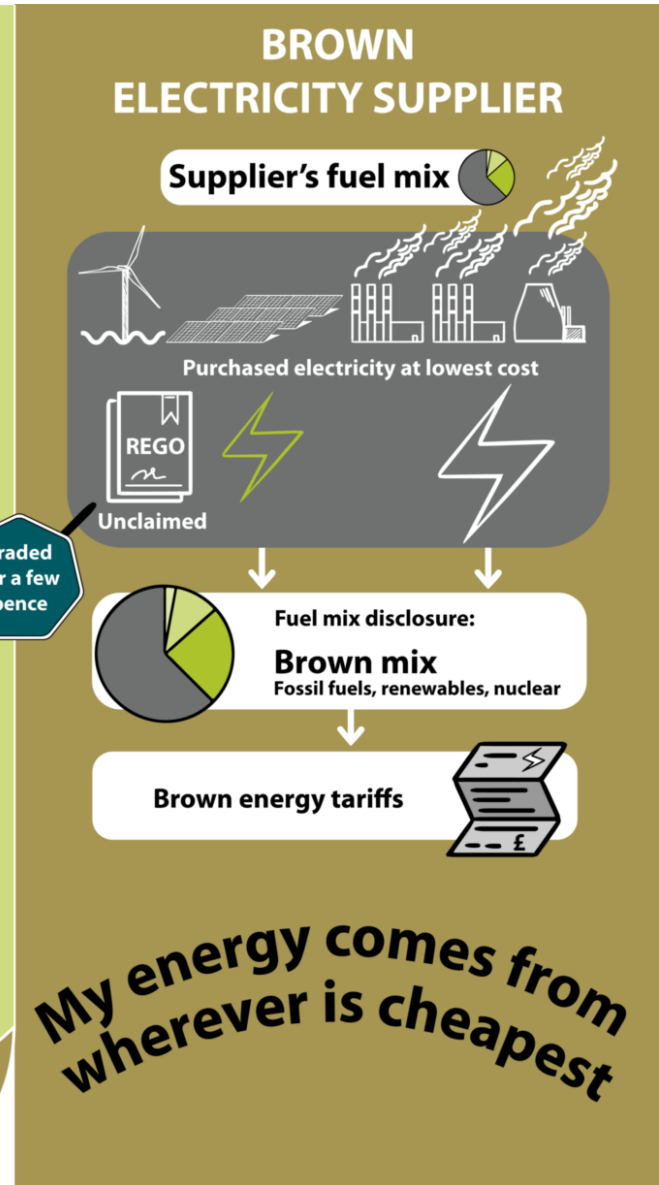
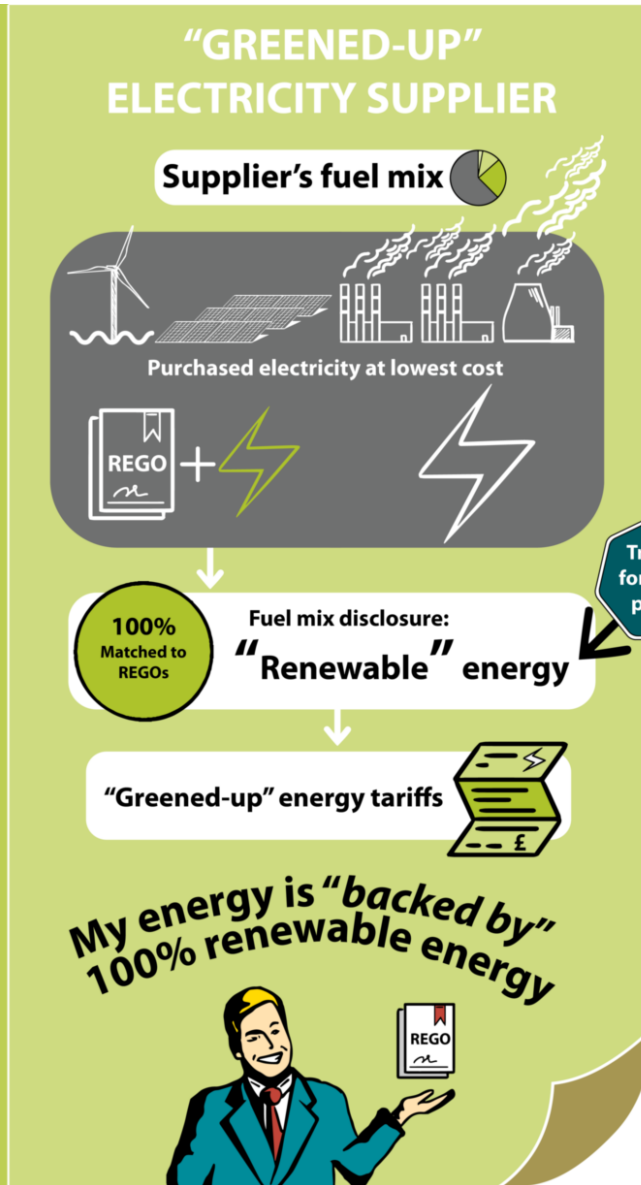
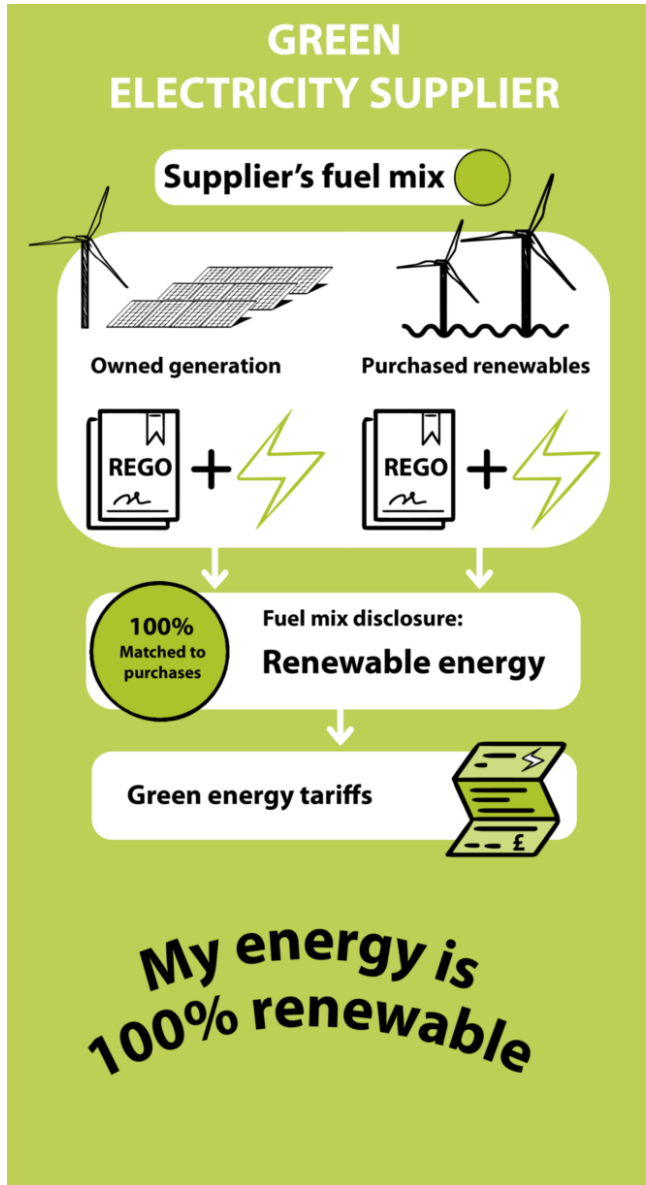


'Intermediary' organisations may find a market
